

## Safeguarding our Children

Dear Parents/Carers,

The safeguarding of our children is our first priority in school. We have tight procedures that are closely followed and updated regularly on the advice of the Safeguarding team at Leeds City Council.

We will be asking for your permission for the following safeguarding requirements. Please complete the following permission statements, where applicable for your child, and return the whole form to school straight away. Please cross out the statements that are not appropriate or that you do not agree to. *By signing at the bottom of the form, you agree to all the statements that you have not crossed out.* This form will then be kept with your child's record and reviewed on a yearly basis.

## For all parents/carers to complete:

- 1. I give permission for photographs of my child to be used in the following formats by school:
  - Paper based documents/publication
  - Internet media eg Twitter, school website and blogs
  - Video
  - Policy documents
  - News media (e.g. newspaper items)
- 2. I give permission for my child to safely access the internet to support their learning during school.
- 3. I give permission for my child to walk with staff and other pupils around our local community and access local amenities during school time. All these activities are fully supervised with the correct staff and pupil ratios.
- 4. I give permission for my child to visit the farm, handle the animals, feed and clean them out under the supervision of an adult if they wish to.
