# OUR NURSERY

- At Fieldhead Carr Primary School, we are passionate that our children feel secure in enabling environments and form positive relationships with the people they spend time with. We want them to develop language to communicate with others, share and cooperate and form basic concepts which help them understand the world we live in.
- It is our aim to give the whole family an enjoyable start to school life when they join our school. We are committed to offering each and every child inspirational learning experiences that set them on their learning journey.





## THE LEARNING LANDSCAPE

- Children learn best through play in an environment that promotes exploration and so resources are organised to provide a wide range of areas of provision, each promoting learning opportunities across some or all of the areas of experience. These areas are regularly enhanced to support learning across different themes and to follow children's particular interests.



## NURSERY SESSIONS

- Universal entitlement is 15 hours a week.
- 5 am sessions or 5 pm sessions
- am session – 8:45am – 11:45am
- pm session – 12:15pm – 3.15pm
- Or 2.5 days (MTWam/WVpmTF) charge for lunch £4
- 30 hours eligibility depends on if you are working and how much you earn. There is a charge of £4 per day and this includes half hour additional care and a school lunch. (children are in school 32.5 hours over the week)

- You can buy additional sessions to make a full day. This costs £14.85
- There is also a school club offering wrap around care. I can email details on request.



## SNACK TIME

We operate a rolling snack system and children are encouraged to independently wash hands prior to selecting milk or water and fruit snack. These are readily available throughout the session. Because of the stricter guidance surrounding Covid, we will monitor this and may adopt a snack time and eat together.



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## SCHOOL LUNCH

If you choose to access 30 hours entitlement, or you pay for full days, your child will have lunch at school.

The current situation means there is a limited menu. Once I know the weekly choices, I will make sure you know what there is available.

Choices will be made when in Nursery.

The kitchen team will be providing grab bags.

# TAPESTRY – LEARNING JOURNAL

- Tapestry builds a very special record of a child's experiences, development and learning journey through their early years. Using photos and videos, a teacher and early years practitioner, along with the child's parents, 'weaves' the story of the child and how they are growing and developing.
- All information held in the platform is stored securely, and can be downloaded and shared as required. Parents are able to view online their child's progress and how much fun they're having, whilst also uploading their own comments and media.
