

# Key Instant Recall Facts

## Year 5 - Summer 1

I know decimal number bonds to 1 and 10.

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts *instantly*.

Decimal number bonds to 1	Decimal number bonds to 10
e.g.	e.g.
$0.1 + 0.9 = 1$	$1.1 + 8.9 = 10$
$0.2 + 0.8 = 1$	$1.2 + 8.8 = 10$
$0.3 + 0.7 = 1$	$1.3 + 8.7 = 10$
$0.4 + 0.6 = 1$	$1.4 + 8.6 = 10$
$0.5 + 0.5 = 1$	$1.5 + 8.5 = 10$
What other facts do they know can help with these number bonds?	What strategies can they use to help with this?

### Top tips:

The secret to success is practicing **little** and **often**. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during your car journey? You don't need to practise them all at once: perhaps you could have a fact of the day.
